Description of Your Packages

Your SAS Activity-Based Management software comes in a single installation kit, labeled SAS Activity-Based Management Select SAS Server. In addition, an Oros folder is included in your software package.

How to Proceed

Be sure to terminate all non-essential applications before proceeding with the installation of any CD. Disable any anti-virus software that may be running.

- □ To identify the installation kit that contains SAS Activity-Based Management Select SAS Server, see the product listing on the SAS 9.1.3 label on each kit.
- □ Read and complete all of the steps in the *QuickStart Guide* in order to install SAS Activity-Based Management Select SAS Server.
- □ Locate the **SAS Activity-Based Management** CD in the media container(s) inside your installation kit. Insert the CD into your CD-ROM drive and follow the instructions that open to install the required software.
- ☐ The remaining steps are for the client machine. If your client machine will be different than your server, go to the client machine.
- □ Locate the **SAS Client-Side Components, Volume 1** CD in the media container(s) inside your installation kit. Insert the CD into your CD-ROM drive and respond to the prompts. When the **SAS Client-Side Components Volume 1** window opens, find and click *SAS Management Console* in the left-hand pane. Follow the instructions that appear in the right-hand pane to install SAS Management Console.
- □ Locate the **SAS Enterprise Guide** CD in the media container(s) inside your installation kit. Insert the CD into your CD-ROM drive and respond to the prompts. Follow the instructions in the wizard to install SAS Enterprise Guide.
- □ Locate the folder containing Oros software. Read and complete the instructions in that folder to install the Oros software on your client machine.
